BULETTEN

Buletten, also known as meat Frikadellen, are made of ground meat mixed with softened Brötchen (bread rolls), and are one of Berlin's favorite dishes.

Ingredients:

0.5 kg of ground beef and ground pork, or just ground pork

2 stale rolls, sliced or crumbled

1 large onion

1 tablespoon fresh chopped parsley

2 small eggs

salt and pepper to taste

8 tablespoons vegetable oil

1 tablespoon butter



Preparation:

1. Place the crumbled rolls in a bowl and pour in about 1 cup of lukewarm water, cover with a dish cloth. Peel and dice the onion.
2. Knead the ground meat with the eggs, parsley, and the softened bread. Season with salt and pepper. With damp hands, form the mixture into about 8 balls, then flatten them partially.
3. Heat the vegetable oil in a large pan and brown both sides of the meatballs well. Turn the heat down to medium and fry for another 10 or 15 minutes, adding the butter during this time.
4. Remove the meatballs from the pan and let them drain on paper towels. Best served with potato salad, rolls, and mustard.

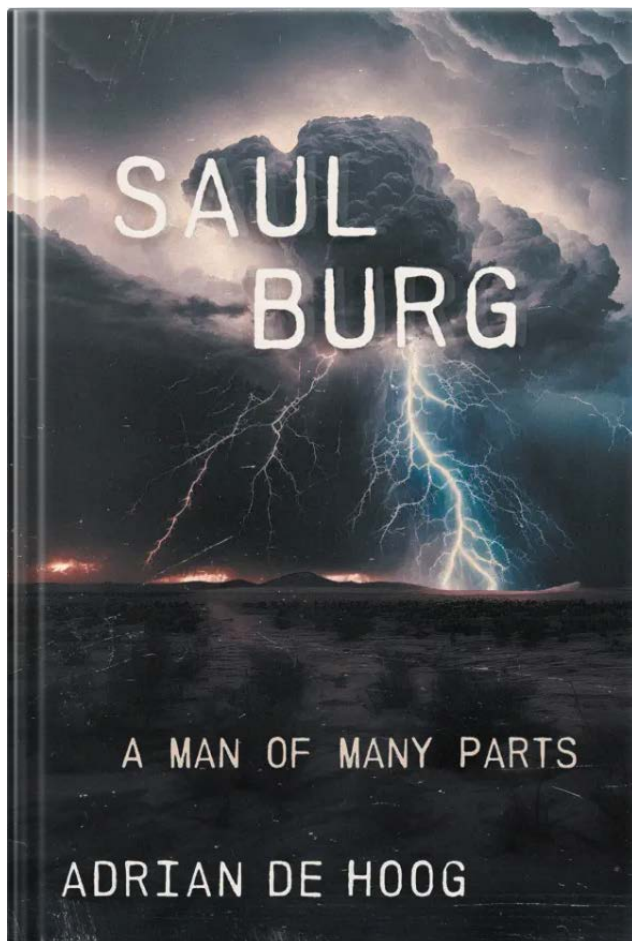

SAUL BURG - A MAN OF MANY PARTS

Who is Saul Burg? How does a fierce man with a shrouded past become Special High Representative to the UN Secretary-General, responsible for coordinating humanitarian work in failed states?

In 1954, deep in Israel's Negev Desert, Palestinian fedayeen massacred the occupants of a bus trundling through the hills between Eilat and Beersheba. The sole survivor, eight-year-old Saul, suddenly orphaned, was placed with a German kibbutz in Galilee, growing up in a rich cultural envelope. As he matured and rationalised the moment his parents were killed, a contempt for terrorists accompanied him into adulthood.

The military call up pivoted him from farming to fighting and a lifelong confrontation with terrorism began.

As an Israeli special forces soldier, he killed terrorists covertly; as an operative with Mossad, he eliminated still more.

Saul transitioned from Mossad hitman to spy master. Germany's ambassador in Tel Aviv took notice of his abilities and arranged recruitment into Germany's Intelligence Service. A decade later, 9/11 brought Saul Burg a further assignment—a post in Berlin to advance Germany's contribution to the global war on terror.

Sixty years after the bus massacre, hardened by a lifetime spent battling terrorism's darkness, yet pursuing enlightened thinking, and sometimes falling under the influence of strong women, Saul relocates from Berlin to Geneva to oversee UN humanitarian work.

Working with him in Geneva is Blake Caldwell, a tech-savvy young assistant. Blake builds databases to track the global humanitarian effort; his search tools uncover names ...

This gripping novel with two interwoven timelines explores Saul's enduring fight against terrorism and Blake's quest to unravel his identity.

Author Adrian de Hoog was born in the Netherlands, his family emigrating to Brandon in 1957. He attended Brandon College, then studied at the universities of Saskatchewan and Oxford. That same year he joined the Canadian Foreign Service, serving as Canada's Consul-General in Berlin shortly after the Berlin wall came down. De Hoog retired from foreign service in 2004 and is now pursuing a career as writer.

His first novel, *The Berlin Assignment*, was published in 2006. The second, *Borderless Deceit*, followed in 2007. His latest, *Natalia's Peace*, tackles issues such as the causes of international conflict and what can be done to address them. He now lives in Ottawa and Berlin.

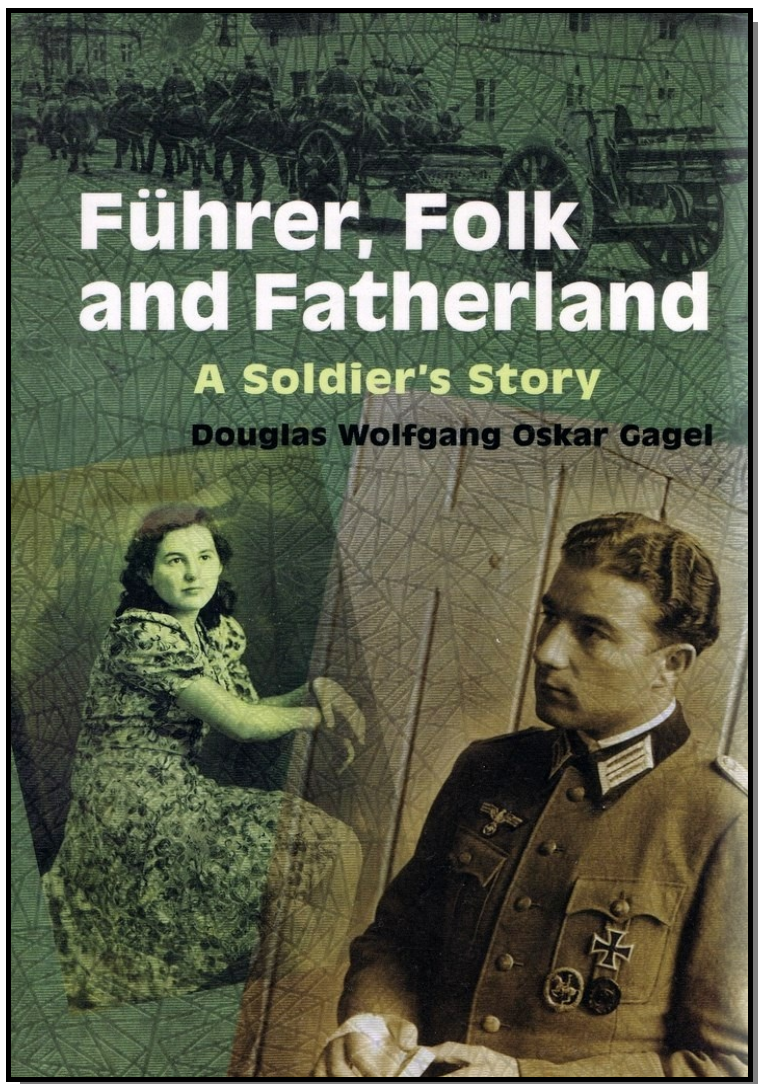

INTRODUCTION

This book represents almost twelve years of research into each individual family to see how many descendants originated from each family who came and settled over here and then where some went west, and some down south to the States.

It is amazing the stamina that they had, to endure the hardships of leaving family and friends in the old country and the uncertainty of the ocean crossing, the fear that they might never see land again. The agony of seeing their children dying with disease on the ship and being buried at sea. Never knowing what was lying in store for them when they did reach land. Those people had to have a very strong faith in their God and in each other to go across the world to begin a new life in a country that was only hearsay. To come to the wilderness and begin to carve their home out of trees and hills and land covered by forest, the first winter with not enough clothing and food to survive on. But survive they did, to raise large families, clothe and feed them, nurse them through diphtheria, small pox, and black fever and all the other smaller deceases, some lived and others died, sometimes two and three in one day.

We can't begin to imagine how they could keep on from day to day and still seem to be happy and content with what they had. It is a wonder that there were so few suicides in those days compared to today's rates. Now we have everything our hearts desire and we're not happy, and life is so hectic with the rush to get more.

I have enjoyed working on this book and at the same time doing the Schwartz book and the Feierabend and Riebertz family book. It was interesting how they had all intermarried over in Prussia and to come over and intermarry here also. Only in the last 30 - 40 years have the younger generation branched out and married other nationalities and moved farther away in search of work.

I hope that everyone who gets one of my books will enjoy reading it, since everyone was so closely intermarried I just could not finish the entire family as it should be, as their immediate family would be in four to six times over and the book would get too big. I have referred you to other families to get the rest. I am hoping that I have not left any families out, also I hope that the spelling and dates are correct. I have tried to be as accurate as possible and I apologise for any incorrect information. The lot nos are not complete but I was trying to establish approximate locations of where they settled. I would like to thank everyone who has sent me information and pictures on their family, without your help I would not have been able to complete each family.
